Dates: April 28- 30, 2012

Cost: \$235 tuition only – no lodging

\$235 tuition + \$50 for 3 nights lodging, showers and use of kitchen (food not included)

\$15/person – shower pass – use of lodge showers during the course.

The Wilderness Medicine Institute (WMI) Wilderness First Responder Recertification training program is a nationally recognized program that updates trained students to respond to emergencies in remote settings. This 24-hour scenario-based curriculum is ideal for current Wilderness First Responders and Wilderness EMTs. The course includes Adult/child CPR and FBAO. The WFR Recertification course is pre-approved for 18 hours of EMT CEU's by CECBEMS.

If you hold a current WFR certification of 70 hours you will receive a WMI WFR certification upon successful completion of your WFR Recert course

If you hold a valid WFR certification from WMI we ask you to bring your certification card so that the instructor can verify your expiration date. Students holding a current WFR certification from any other organization are **REQUIRED** to submit a photocopy of their certification card on the first day of the course. If you hold a current WFR certification from any other wilderness medicine organization with less than 70 hours, you will receive a letter of course completion in lieu of a WMI WFR certification. This letter of completion may allow you to recertify with your original certifying organization. You must contact that organization prior to your WMI course to ensure that our course will meet their requirements.

All students are required to submit a photocopy of their WFR certification card on the first day of the course.

There is a one-year grace period for recertification of WMI cards. (Keep in mind that you are not current during this grace period and therefore cannot work as a Wilderness First Responder.) Please check your card closely.

You will be required to complete a **WRITTRN EXAM** at the **BEGINNING** of the course. Check the following web page for information and resources on how to best prepare for your course:

Upon successful completion of practical and written exams, you will receive an updated WMI Wilderness First Responder and American Heart Association's Heartsaver CPR certifications. These are both 2-year certifications.

Registration and Cancellation

A **\$100 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit is required to reserve your place.** The balance is due thirty days prior to the class beginning (April 30, 2011). If we are forced to cancel the course for any reason, a full refund will be given. You may pay via MasterCard or Visa

Class Format and Where to Meet

Please check in by 7:45am on April 30th in the Griffith Lodge at the Breckenridge Outdoor Education Center. Class typically starts at 8:00am and finishes by 5:00pm.. Quiz's, lecture material followed by scenario sessions, role-playing, simulated rescues and improvisation drills are all part of the day-to-day activities. Role playing exercises are held both indoors and out. Equip yourself accordingly to be outside in inclement weather. You are expected to attend all scheduled classes.

Equipment and Clothing required for the course:

- ✓ Water bottle
- ✓ Outdoor Clothing suitable for early spring at elev. 10,000 ft. (be ready for snow, rain, wind etc)
- ✓ Small notebook with pens and pencils
- ✓ Watch with second hand.
- ✓ Sunscreen and sunglasses

Suggested for the course :

Crazy Creek® chair (or similar)
Indoor Shoes or hut slippers
Sleeping Bag

Flashlight or headlamp w/spare batteries
Large daypack
Hiking Poles

Answers to other Commonly Asked Questions

- Unfortunately we cannot allow pets at our site (this includes: dogs, cats, iguanas, raccoons, baboons, etc.).
- Your textbook and course manual is included in the tuition and you will receive it upon arrival.
- The above listed equipment and clothing are necessary for the outdoor classroom setting.
- The additional equipment items are optional and used to demonstrate backcountry evacuation and rescue techniques.

Lodging

Lodging at the BOEC's Griffith Lodge is \$50 and includes 3 nights in bunk style rooms, showers and the use of the kitchen for meal preparation. Lodging is limited to 20 participants, so please sign up early if you are planning on staying. **Lodge check-in begins after 6:00 pm, Friday April 27th (night before course start).** Food is not provided, but there is a City Market in town where you can buy groceries. Smoking is prohibited in the Lodge. **Camping is not allowed on our site**, so if you plan to camp, we can make some suggestions on some locations nearby. **Additionally, if you chose to camp, you will not have access to the lodge facilities to cook, shower etc.** For additional lodging information/reservations, contact the Breckenridge Resort Chamber at 1-800-221-1091.

Shower Passes

For those not staying at the Griffith Lodge, we will offer a shower pass for \$15. This will allow you showers during the course. Bring your own towel. Show passes will be available the first day of the course.

Please read the enclosed document(s) very carefully as it affects your legal rights. We ask that you send both documents to our office along with your payment.
