

SUMMER YOUTH RENDEVOUS

What is SUMMER YOUTH RENDEVOUS?

New this year the BOEC is offering a 4 day course specially designed for young adults who have been diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis. The camp requires that students be fully independent with self-care tasks or bring an assistant to help with personal care needs.



Through outdoor activities, designed around established adventure education models, students will have the opportunity to be active and have fun with their peers within a community that understands MS and Adventure. This is based in Breckenridge at the BOEC program site. From there activities will include, rafting, climbing and ropes course. Students will be involved in cooking, cleaning and gear preparation during the course; however, the emphasis will be on having fun and being appropriately challenged.

Cost: \$500 (Scholarship information is included in the application packet)

Included in trip cost:

Food, specialty gear such as life jackets, transportation while on course and 24-hour instruction/supervision by BOEC professional staff

Day 2: Teambuilding and Rock Climbing Day

Day 3: River Rafting on the Upper Colorado

Day 4: Ropes Course, Closing and Departure 1:30 PM
